The candidate should submit a letter from the HoD certifying that thesis is under process of approval.
- Candidates should submit a manuscript based on their thesis work for consideration for the award.
- ❖ The manuscript must be in the format of an original article, following the Indian Pediatrics "Instructions to Authors".
- The manuscript should not exceed 2,500 words and may include a maximum of 25 references.
- A one-page summary (maximum 500 words) should accompany the manuscript, highlighting why the thesis research merits the award.
- A certificate from the Head of the Department or Unit must be provided, confirming:
 - ◆ The thesis is the candidate's own work.
 - ◆ The thesis has been accepted by the university / institute or under process of approval .
 - There is no restriction on the number of entries submitted from any department or institution.
